

NEED TO DRIVE FOR AVERETT

- Must be at least 19 years old
- Must have had a valid U.S. driver's license for at least 3 years

If you anticipate any of the following, you must qualify as a Regular Driver:

- a. Transporting students for any reason one or more times;
- b. Driving a vehicle owned by Averett University;
- c. Renting a vehicle in Averett University's name or towing a trailer for Averett University; or
- d. Driving a personal vehicle on a regular (weekly) basis as part of your Averett University employment (e.g. visits to potential donors, students, families off campus), excluding driving from one Averett Campus to another in the Danville Region.

HOW TO QUALIFY AS A DRIVER

- STEP 1: Complete the online Averett University Regular Driver Application. Read the policy, watch the video, and submit your results.

- STEP 3: You will receive an email from **Bren Taylor** (**btaylor@hes.com**) with the results of your driver authorization application. Please note that until you receive this authorization **you are not approved to drive Averett University vehicles**.
