Averett Partners with the Marines

On March 20, Averett announced the formation of a partnership with the United States Marine Corps (USMC) that will allow students to apply to the USMC's Officer Training Program. This partnership, which was more than two years in the making, is similar to an ROTC program. However, it's an untraditional program in that students who are enrolled take part in USMC training during the summer months and continue their academic coursework at Averett during the academic year. Then, once students graduate from Averett, they will be commissioned as an officer in the Marine Corps.



Coming Soon: Improvements for AU Students

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, three exciting new projects are either underway or starting soon that will benefit Averett students: 1. More advanced Biology and Chemistry labs:

Two older labs will soon be combined into one large and much-improved lab featuring nine new work stations, new black lab sinks, new faucets and new cabinets with sliding glass doors. Upgrades to other labs will include a new 10' fume hood with corrosive and flammable storage cabinets and more. (Total cost: approximately \$85,000, all fully funded by the Carrington Trust, Centra and an anonymous donor.) 2. First-in-class technology for Nursing students: Averett's Nursing students will soon be equipped with new technology that includes mobile medication carts, electronic medical records and iPads. Frith Fine Arts Center) is getting a major facelift, including a refinished gym floor, a new ceiling, new backboards, new plexiglass windows, an upgraded bathroom and a new heating and air conditioning system. (Total cost: approximately \$125,000, all fully funded.)
