Academics

- Paper/Notebooks/Binders
- Textbooks
- Bookbag

Bedding

- Comforter/Blankets
- Sheets (Appropriately Sized Twin XL)
- Pillows/Pillow Cases

Bath

- Towels/Washcloths
- Shower Shoes/Flip Flops
- Shower Caddy

Personal Hygiene/ Health Supplies

- Shampoo/Conditioner/Other Body Washes
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Hair Products/Hair Dryers
- First Aid Kit
- Thermometer
- Medication (Prescription/Over The Counter)

Laundry/ Supplies

- Laundry Basket
- Detergent
- Cleaning Supplies
- Paper Towels/Cleaning Rags

Electronics

- Cell phone with charger
- Computer/Laptop with chargers and locking cables
- Earbuds/Headphones

Personal Information

- Debit/Credit Cards
- Driver's License
- Insurance Card

Storage

- Hangers
- Trash/Recycle Can (Appropriately Sized)

***Prohibited Items:** the possession and/or use of any large appliances or any of the following small appliances and electrical equipment is strictly prohibited in residential facilities:

Halogen lights

Toaster Ovens or hot plates

Air fryers

Any appliances with exposed heating elements

Electric frying pans

Refrigerators larger than 3.5 cubic feet

Space heaters (unless issued by the University)

Extension cords (unless they are UL approved with grounded power strips with fuses)

Hammocks or porch swings

Grills of any type
